What you will need:

- 1. Everything to make at least 5-7 gallons of chili on your tailgate or street.
- 2. No pre-chopped veggies unless they are purchased that way and are stored sealed. No handmade canned goods may be used.

- 3. You will need to bring your own handwashing station which can consist of a dishpan and an igloo container with a container underneath to catch the waste water, a roll of paper towels and soap.
- 4. Bring extra cooking utensils, serving utensils and meat thermometer for your Station. No crockpots.
- 5. List of ingredients. If you have wild game, please make everyone AWARE.
- 6. Water will be provided, if needed.
- 7. Long hair must be pulled back or contained with a cap or hair-net.
- 8. Gloves will be provided.
- 9. Bring your own overhead protection. (Ex. Easy up pop-up canopy)
