### **Lake County Internet Growth Survey – Broadband Initiative**

We continue to need both resident and non-resident landowners in Lake County to take the broadband survey to improve our internet service in Lake County. To take the survey, go to **2020LakeCounty.com**. You can choose a survey that best describes your role in the community: Household, Business, Agriculture, Health, Higher Education, K-12, Organization, Public Safety, or Government. You can complete more than one survey. For instance, you can take one for your household, one for your business you might operate from your home, and one because you belong to an organization that would send you email. For this example, you could complete three surveys.

Visitors to Lake County are also encouraged to complete the survey because you may need to maintain contact with others or conduct business while vacationing in Lake County.

The more participation we have on this survey, the quicker we are likely to receive better internet service in our county.
