

Luther Lions Club


- Luther Area Museum/Luther Lions Club Annual Tea will be held on Saturday, October 2, at 1pm.

Lake County Internet Committee


Lake County Internet Committee announced today, it is working to help build consumer awareness about the Emergency Broadband Benefit, a new Federal Communications Commission (FCC) program. The temporary benefit will help to lower the cost of broadband service for eligible households during the on-going COVID-19 pandemic.

The \$3.2B Emergency Broadband Benefit program provides a discount of up to a \$50 per month toward broadband service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for qualifying households on qualifying Tribal lands. The benefit also provides up to a \$100 per household discount toward a one-time purchase of a computer, laptop, or tablet if the household contributes more than \$10 and less than \$50 toward the purchase through a participating broadband provider.

A household is eligible if one member of the household meets at least one of the criteria below:

- Has an income that is at or below 135% of the <u>Federal Poverty Guidelines</u> or participates in certain assistance programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid or the FCC's <u>Lifeline</u> program;
- Approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision, in the 2019-2020 or 2020-2021 school year;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
- Experienced a substantial loss of income through job loss or furlough since February 29, 2020 and the household had a total income in 2020 at or below \$99,000 for single filers and \$198,000 for joint filers; or
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income or COVID-19 program.

Emergency Broadband Benefit enrollment will begin (opened) on May 12, 2021. Eligible households can enroll through a <u>participating broadband provider</u> or directly with the <u>Universal Service Administrative Company</u> (<u>USAC</u>) using an online or mail-in application. Hazardous Waste Disposal will be available for Lake, Mecosta and Osceola Counties on Saturday, October 9, from 9am to 12 noon at the following sites:

Lake County – Wenger Pavilion, downtown Baldwin (behind Jones Ice Cream Parlor)

Mecosta County – Mecosta County Fairgrounds, 540 West Ave., Big Rapids

Osceola County – Road Commission North Facility, 13353 20-Mile Rd., Tustin

Pre-registration is required if you have over 200 lbs. of waste for disposal and must be submitted two weeks prior to the collection date.
